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CONSENT AGREEMENT

This Consent Agreement, dated this 19th day of December, 2006, is between the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners ("Board") and Leslie K. Taylor, D.V.M., ("Dr Taylor"), License No. 3154. The Agreement concerns the charges that the Board filed against Dr. Taylor alleging that she practiced veterinary medicine in this State during a time period that she was not registered as a licensed veterinarian in this State, a violation of Agriculture Article, §2-313, Annotated Code of Maryland.

Under State law, the Board is the licensing authority responsible for regulating the practice of veterinary medicine in this State, which includes filing disciplinary actions against veterinarians charged with violating the provisions of the Veterinary Practice Act and regulations adopted thereunder. The Board "may refuse, suspend, or revoke any application or license, and censure or place on probation any licensee ... if the veterinarian ... [f]ails to comply with [the Veterinary Practice Act and] Board rules and regulations after receiving a license" (Md. Code Ann., Agric. Art., §2-310(8)); and in lieu of, or in addition to, suspending a veterinarian's license, the Board may impose a civil penalty of not more than \$5,000 (Md. Code Ann., Agric. Art., §2-310.1).

FINDINGS OF FACTS

Dr. Taylor, by entering into and signing this document, acknowledges that the Board could produce evidence establishing the following Findings of Fact:

1. On or about July 1, 2006 through October 14, 2006 of the 2006-7 Licensing Year (July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007), Dr. Taylor practiced veterinary medicine at the Canal Clinic located at 9125 River Road, Potomac, MD 20854. During this time period,

however, Dr. Taylor was not registered to practice as a licensed veterinarian in this State.

2. On June 30, 2006, Dr. Taylor's registration for the 2006-7 Licensing Year expired. She failed to take steps on or before that date to renew it.

3. On or about October 25, 2006, Ms. Robin Roscher, an Inspector with the Board, obtained medical records from the Canal Clinic, showing that Dr. Taylor treated animals at this facility during the period that her registration had lapsed (July 1, 2006 through October 14, 2006).

4. Dr. Taylor has since taken steps to renew her registration for the 2006-7 Licensing Year.

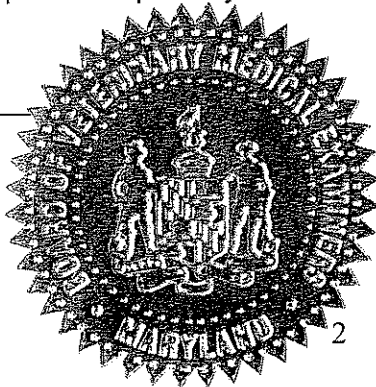
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

Based upon these Findings of Fact, the Board makes the following Conclusion of Law: On or about July 1, 2006 and through October 14, 2006, Dr. Taylor practiced veterinary medicine at the Canal Clinic located at 9125 River Road, Potomac, MD 20854 but, during this time period, was not registered as a licensed veterinarian in this State, a violation of Agriculture Article, §2-313, Annotated Code of Maryland.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, finding that Dr. Taylor violated the Veterinary Practice Act, it is this 19th day of December, 2006, by the State Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners, **ORDERED**: That Dr. Taylor is assessed a Civil Penalty in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00). The Board acknowledges receipt of this penalty.

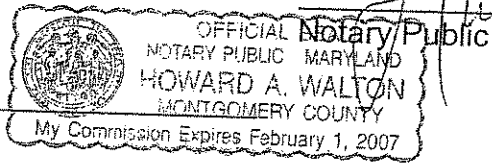
